

Aldersbrook Primary School – Toileting Policy

Before a forest schools session, all children are asked to visit the toilet for a 'magic wee'. Children will be allowed to use a selected area for toileting. If a child asks for help with this, they are only allowed to be accompanied by a member of staff from Aldersbrook Primary School or their own parent.

All children will be shown how to dig a toilet hole correctly. Young children may require the hole to be dug for them but should then be left alone to use the toilet:

- Take a shovel/trowel from the forest school truck along with toilet roll. Select a secluded area outside of the forest school boundary and dig the hole.
- Dig a hole around 30cm deep.
- Deposit in the hole, including the toilet paper, and cover it with a handful of leaf litter.
- Refill the hole with the removed soil.
- Wash hands when back in the activity area.
