Free School Meals and Pupil Premium Funding

The Government is giving money to schools to help children from lower income families do their very best. This funding is called a 'Pupil Premium'. For every child registered Aldersbrook Primary School will receive a maximum of £1320 this year.

With this money we could provide:

- + Opportunities for funded learning support such as tuition and after school activities
- + Free music tuition
- + Reduced costs for educational visits and residential trips
- + Subsidised after school clubs
- + Subsidised Breakfast Club
- + A free book from the school Book Fair
- + Free school 'Starter Pack' (including a dictionary, Maths resources, P.E bag etc.).
- + More interventions to accelerate your child's academic progress
- + Interventions to develop self-esteem, self-confidence and social emotional skills.

Who Qualifies for Free School Meals and Pupil Premium funding?

Free School Meals and Pupil Premium funding can only be awarded if you or your partner are claiming:

- + Income Support
- + Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- + Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- + Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- + The guarantee element of Pension Credit
- + Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- + Working Tax Credit run-on – paid for four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- + Universal Credit applied on or after 1st April 2018 (provided you have an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400, as assessed by earnings from up to three of your most recent assessment periods)

If you feel you meet the criteria, please complete the [online form](#) to initiate possible Pupil Premium funding for your child, regardless of the fact that all **Reception, Year 1 and Year 2** children receive Universal Infant Free School Meals. If your child enters **Year 3** in 2019/20 they are no longer automatically eligible for free school meals under the Universal Infant Free School Meals Scheme, again if you meet the criteria set-out above, please apply via the Redbridge website. Finally, if your child has entered **Years 4, 5 or 6** and you feel you meet the criteria visit the website as funding will continue under the condition of Forever Six, which will continue into Secondary education. If your circumstances for Free School Meals have changed, making you ineligible but have since changed again, please re-apply for Free School Meals at the above web address. Applications are confidential and it will not affect any other benefits you are claiming.
