The Kit List

- Both year groups will need packed lunch (in a plastic bag) for the first day only
 - 2 days clothes including: T-shirts, shorts and trousers, night wear, underwear x 3, socks x 3, Warm Jumper and Coat
 - Sweatshirt or jumper and tracksuit bottoms
 - Wellies & old trainers
 - Waterproof jacket/trousers
 - Plastic Dinner Plate, cup & cereal bowl
 - Knife, fork, spoon
 - T-towel
 - Sun Tan Lotion
 - Sun Hat
 - Sleeping mat
 - Sleeping bag and pillow
 - Blanket
 - Teddy
 - Wash bag (Soap, toothpaste and brush)
 - Large Towel
 - Camping Chair (suggested)
 - Medication (if necessary)
 - Toilet roll
 - Torch + new batteries
 - Spending Money (£3 Maximum to be given to the class teacher in a clearly marked envelope with the child's name and class)
 - Keep a set of clothes in a separate plastic bag with child's name in case of wet weather
 - Label all items with name and class
 - Plastic bag/sack for dirty or wet clothes
 - Large Laundry bag for all clothes
(NO suite cases please)
 - Empty bag for dirty clothes
 - NO SWEETS AT NIGHT
- No sweets in tents as this encourages unwanted insects and keeps children awake when they should be sleeping.

ALL MEDICATION MUST BE IN SCHOOL BY FRIDAY 16th September 2022 AT THE LATEST

We can only administer medication that has been prescribed by the GP or labelled by a pharmacist if bought over the counter.

All medication should be placed in an envelope or wallet with your child's name and class, and given to the Main Office.

If you need to discuss any other personal issues regarding your child, please speak to your child's class teacher.
