- Develop a chronologically secure knowledge and understanding of British, local and world history, establishing clear narratives within and across the period of Anglo-Saxon rule in Britain.
- Understand how our knowledge of the past is constructed from a range of sources.
- Use maps, atlases, globes and digital/computer mapping to locate countries and describe features studied.

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English

In English we will be learning:

- To edit and improve our own work
- To learn and apply a range of spellings rules and patterns to our writing.

In Mathematics we will be learning about:
