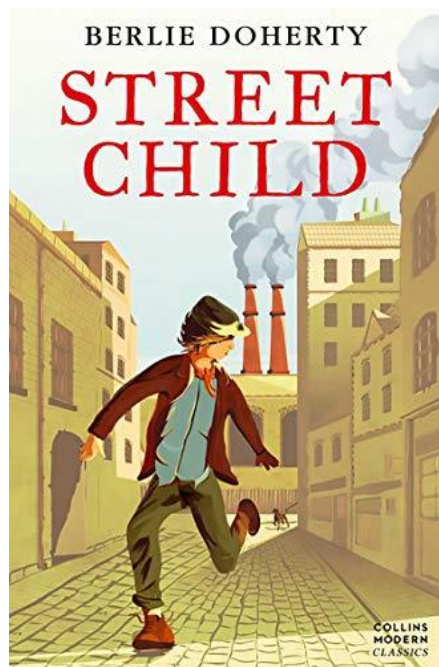


Spring Term Curriculum Overview
