

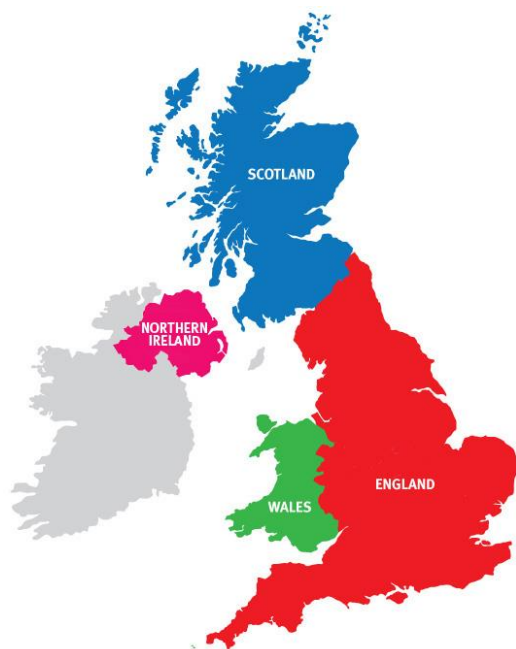
# Spring Term Curriculum Overview

- Parts of the body including senses
