Reception School Applications for September 2023

All Nursery parents are required to submit their child's application for Primary School by **15th January 2023** to their home borough. Parents are required to submit three supporting documents as proof of residency to the borough along with the application. To complete the application please log on to www.redbridge.gov.uk/eAdmissions

If you miss this deadline, your child may not get a school place. Please also note that a place in our Nursery does not guarantee a place in Reception.

Census Day—Thursday 19 January 2023

The funding that our school receives to educate and feed our children is calculated by the London Borough of Redbridge three times a year. Simply put, the number of children who are on roll on that day, the number of families who are Pupil Premium and the number of Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 children who have a school dinner on that day enables the Borough to calculate how much money we, as a school, should receive.

Census Day for the Spring Term is on Thursday 19 January 2023.

What can you do to help?

Sign your child up to have a school meal on **Thursday 19th January**! There is a special and extra delicious menu planned for the day (attached). It is especially important that Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 children have a school meal if at all possible - you can always send in an extra snack for them to have afterwards if you are worried that they won't eat enough at lunchtime that day. If your child is in those year groups and you do not sign them up for a school lunch on Thursday 19th January, the school will not get any funding for any meals for them for the term and the cost of their meals will have to be covered out of school funds.

Please log onto your child's Feeding Hungry Minds account and book lunch for Thursday 19 January.



Winter PE Kit
