Dear Parents & Carers,

Welcome to Summer Term!

We have come back to school to find the daffodils are out in bloom and a lot of new growth on the living wall in Ben's Garden and around the school and there is a real sense of new life and new beginnings (we even have four ducklings that have hatched in EYFS!).

You will know that the four curriculum intent areas that drive all learning in our school are: *Confidence, Independence, Curiosity & Involvement*. The Community Makeover Day coming up on Saturday 20th May is a wonderful way to bring your children along to get *involved* with helping to spruce up their school and give something back—which is an important sentiment for us here at Aldersbrook. Please join us from 12-4pm on the day: we will be digging, painting and having a few laughs so bring some paint brushes, gardening tools and old clothes. It really is a lovely community day as well. **Key Stage 1&2 SATs** are coming up over the next few weeks so we wish the pupils in Year 2 & 6 the best of luck with those. The teachers have been working tirelessly to get the pupils ready in a way that won't stress them out too much and we thank them for their commitment & energy.

We will be holding a Street Party afternoon for **King Charles' Coronation** on **Friday 12th May** (see over for more details). As SATs test are running that morning, the street party will be for pupils only as it will be quite tight to get through all the classes in one afternoon, but we would love it if you could join us at the end of the school day for a cup of tea, cake and some music.

**School Photos** will be going ahead as usual this term, starting from Monday 22nd until Wednesday 24th (dependent on weather as our photos are outside, as requested by parents). Can we ask that your child comes to school in full uniform on those days and for full attendance so that no one is missing from class photos! Bring PE kits with you on those days. Party Pooper time: we have already had several requests for additional time for holidays to be taken outside of the holiday periods of the May half term or Summer holidays. We have *thirteen weeks* of holidays per year and all holidays should be taken in these times. Every day of learning is important and school will not grant permission for holidays in other times when we have so many weeks to plan them in.

Summer Term 2 also sees the start of our **Relationships**, **Sex & Health Education (RSHE)** lessons with all pupils which emphasise how pupils can keep themselves safe and be educated about their own body and how it works. The lessons we use are age appropriate and aimed at empowering all pupils to be **educated & confident** with their growing body. We are holding a parent information session after school on Thursday 18th May in the KS1 playground, where your class teachers and senior leadership team can answer any questions and show you the resources we use.

Pupils have chosen some things to make for the day that reflect their hopes for the King and we will display these on tables in the KS1 playground for parents to see.


