

> Fabula Festival is an annual arts & literature festival organised by Vision Redbridge Culture & Leisure. It's a celebration of the power of libraries to transform young lives.

The festival encourages children of all ages to develop their enjoyment of reading, creative writing and story making through fun workshops and inspiring author events. A new addition for 2023 is a reading challenge where children get to set their own summer reading targets! (see our reading challenge page for further information)

This year we are delighted to host author Ravena Guron at Keith Axon and Hainault Libraries and award- winning writer Michael Mann at Kenneth More Theatre in Ilford.

Ravena Guron is an MG author, a superb new voice who brings her own captivating brand of energy, wild adventure and joy to the genne. Her book, The Thief of Farrowfell is the first in the series following Jude Ripon. It was shortlisted for Penguin's WriteNow scheme, as well as being highly commended in the FAB Prize.

Michael Mann is a teacher and author whose book Ghostcloud was a Waterstones Best Children's Book of 2021, a Guardian pick and included in the Book Trust Great Books Guide 2022.

Pupils will have an opportunity to buy the authors books in advance and both events will be followed by book signings by the authors.

This education programme is offered for free to Redbridge schools, on a first come first served basis. Feedback on previous events from teachers:
