Supersonic Phonic Friends—Firm Foundations in Phonics 1

Phase One activities are arranged under the following seven aspects.

- Aspect 1: General sound discrimination environmental sounds
- Aspect 2: General sound discrimination instrumental sounds
 - Aspect 3: General sound discrimination body percussion
 - Aspect 4: Rhythm and rhyme
 - Aspect 5: Alliteration
 - Aspect 6: Voice sounds
 - Aspect 7: Oral blending and segmenting

Phonics

This Term we will be looking at Aspect 7 of Phase 1 Phonics. This aspect involves oral segmenting and blending.

Segment = Breaking up of words into their sounds e.g. c-a-t.

Blending = Process of combining sounds together e.g. cat.

Here are some CVC (consonant, vowel, consonant) words you can try segmenting and blending at home;

cat, mat, pig, log, bin, sun, ant, mix, dog.

Definitions;

Segment = Breaking up of words into their sounds e.g. c-a-t


