 Geography: We will learn about the seaside and how it has changed over the years.

This term, we will be learning:

- **History**: We will be looking at how we have changed since we were babies, who is in our family and where we are from. We will be sequencing key events in our lives to help us understand what history is and how it affects us.
- Art: We will be learning about the primary colours and mixing them.
- **D&T**: We will be looking at how to make a healthy snack for our seaside day in school.
- **Computing**: We will be learning to programme a moving robot. We will be using an algorithm to instruct a Bee Bot to navigate around the classroom.
- **PSHE**: We will be learning about economic well-being and the importance of it to us.
- **Music**: We will learning about Florence Price and listening to Juba Dance.
- **PE**: We will be learning how to play some invasion games.
- **RE**: We will learning about how different religions celebrate the birth of a baby.

English

In English we will be learning about:

- Handwriting and letter formation
- Consistently accurate use of full stops and capital letters.
- Appropriate use of adjectives
- Use of and to join two sentences together.
- Accurately using the letter I to talk about ourselves.
- How to use suffixes and prefixes (such as un-, -ed, -ing)

Maths

In Maths we will be learning about:

- Place value within 100
- Money
- Addition and subtraction within 50
- Counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.
- Shape
- Multiplication and Division
- Using our previous knowledge to answer reasoning and problem solving questions.



We will be growing our own sunflowers and peas to observe the changes as plants grow.

We will also be learning to label the basic parts of a plant (e.g. root, stem, leaves, petals etc.).

Please help your child to name as many plants and trees in the local area.
