- Geography: We will learn about Japan.

We will read:

We will be writing:

• Monologues, letters, character descriptions and narratives.

Phonics:

- We will be learning alternative Phase 5 sounds.
- We will be recapping Phase 6 spelling

Maths

- We will be learning about statistics, representing data using tally charts, pictograms and block diagrams.
- We will be looking at direction and position.
- We will be learning about time, focusing on quarter past and quarter to.
- We will practice worded maths problems with the four operations the children have learnt.

Science

- To know that humans have offspring which grow into adults.
- To find out about and describe the basic needs for survival (food, water, air etc.)
- Describe the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food, and hygiene.
