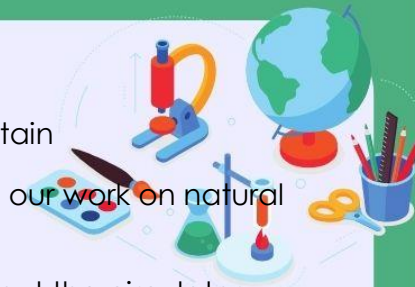
**French:** learning and practising how to speak and write: What is/ isn't possible using nouns and verbs in relative clauses
