This term, we will be learning:



- History: We will be analysing primary and secondary sources to find out how people lived in ancient Egypt and why we remember them
- Geography: We will be learning about modern Egypt
- Art: We will be sculpting ancient Egyptian death masks using Modroc
- RE: We will be learning about what it means to be Jewish
- Computing: We will be learning about how the Internet works and how we use it in our everyday lives
- PE: We will spent this half term practising a range of footballing skills
- In Music, 4T and 4L will be listening to The Little Train of the Ciapira by Heitor Vila Lobos while 4H learn how to play the cornet
- In French, we will be learning our numbers from 21-31, months of the year, birthdays and more!

Science



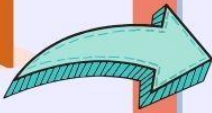
Our Science topic is Living Things and their Habitat. We will be:
