Geography: We will learn about Japan.

We will be learning alternative Phase 5 sounds. We will also be recapping Phase 6 spelling rules.

Maths



We will be learning about statistics, representing data using tally charts, pictograms and block diagrams.

We will be looking at direction and position.

We will be learning about time, focusing on quarter past and quarter to.

We will practice worded maths problems with the four operations the children have learnt.

Science



We will be describing the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food, and hygiene.

We will also be exploring plants and the best conditions for them to grow in.
