How did the Suffragettes change the course of history for women in Britain?

Our Big Question:

How are we different? How are we the same?



This term, we will be learning:

History: We will be learning about the Suffragettes and their impact on Britain.

Geography: Revisiting previous Topics to secure knowledge and understanding.

Science: Electricity: to recap previous knowledge of electricity and apply skills and knowledge to create a board game.

RE: We will be learning about vows and commitments and how these affect certain relationships.

PE: We will be learning and practising new skills in athletics, tag rugby and football.

Music: In the first half of Summer 2, we will be listening to BBC 10 Pieces: Connect It – Anna Meredith and creating body percussion pieces; in the second half of Summer 2, we will be performing musical pieces and preparing by deep listening to Pauline Oliveros.

French: learning and practising how to speak and write: What is/isn't possible using nouns and verbs in relative clauses.

Art: 3D sculpture - we will learn to represent memories through art, using various materials and techniques.

D&T: cooking and nutrition- to select recipes to create a three course meal.

Computing: we will learn to create and work with spreadsheets.

PSHE: we will be learning about economic well being, drugs and then SRE.

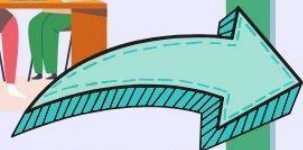
