Topic: Ancient Egypt

This term, we will be learning:



History: We will be analysing primary and secondary sources to find out how people lived in ancient Egypt and why we remember them

Geography: We will be learning about modern Egypt

Art: We will be sculpting ancient Egyptian death masks using Modroc

RE: We will be learning about what it means to be Jewish

Computing: We will be learning about how the Internet works and how we use it in our everyday lives

In Mathematics we will be learning about:

- Number and place value

- Additionally, we will be practising our arithmetic skills everyday

In Science we will be learning about our topic Living Things and their Habitat. We will be:

- Grouping living things
- Exploring classification keys
- Investigating living things in the local and wider environments
- Learning about how environments change
