



INTERNET PERMISSION FORM

As part of the school's ICT programme we offer pupils supervised access to the Internet, the global network of computers you will have read about and seen on television. In order to fully access the Internet all pupils must obtain parental permission.

Access to the Internet will enable pupils to explore thousands of sites, while exchanging messages with other Internet users throughout the world. Families should be warned that some material accessible via the Internet may contain items that are illegal or potentially offensive to some people. Whilst London Grid for Learning and the Redbridge LA provide the school with protection, which makes the majority of such sites inaccessible, this system is not 100% effective.

We believe the benefits to pupils from access to the Internet, exceed any disadvantages. But ultimately, parents and guardians of minors are responsible for setting the standards that their children should follow.

During school, teachers will guide pupils toward suitable materials. Your child will need to complete these tasks as part of their programme of work.

The Managed Learning Environment (Fronter) is a password protected online teaching and learning space where pupils can use a wide range of tools for learning and collaboration, share resources and undertake many different educational activities. They may contribute in discussion forums based on educational topics, take quizzes or tests, access suitable online content and support each other's learning. It is a personalised and interactive webspace that allows teachers to add resources and set tasks relevant to the learning that is going on in the classroom. Children and teachers will be able to create and share many different types of learning materials and collaborate with each other within the MLE. Each child will have their own username and password, which they are responsible for keeping secure, and which will allow you to also become involved in the work they are doing, by joining them from time to time as they log in at home. We are aware that some children will have less access at home than others, and will work as hard as we can to provide opportunities at school to help counteract this, wherever possible.

Before being allowed to use the account, all pupils must obtain parental permission and both they and you must sign and return the enclosed form as evidence of your approval and their acceptance of the school rules on this matter. The MLE will be set up in the new school year.

We would be grateful if you could complete the permission form and return the completed form to your child's class teacher.
