

#### Commitment of the school to:

# Agreement for Parents/Carers

### **Commitment of the Family:**

- make sure our child attends school everyday and is on time for school
- inform the school if our child is absent by telephone on the first day of absence and via email or writing when the child returns
- see that our child wears the school uniform and brings their PE kit on the appropriate days
- encourage our child to work hard and to do all homework tasks, including reading at home
- encourage our child to respect all pupils, adults and property
- contact the school if there are problems at school or at home that may affect our child's work or behaviour
- inform the school of any circumstances that may affect our child including change of telephone number and address
- attend open/parents' evenings and discussions about our child's progress at school
- collect our child on time after school
- ensure healthy packed lunches are provided and school dinners are paid for in advance
- do not stop to drop off or park on the yellow lines outside the school
- ensure your child adheres to the school's 'e-Safety policy' while using ICT at home
