This term we will be learning about... 'Our local area'

The Montessori approach will continue during Year I where there will be numerous activities tailored towards our topic. We will be exploring what the term 'local' means by looking at buildings, different careers and transportation in our local area. This includes a visit to our local fields and forest.

Children will look at maps of the local area and think about their route to school. They will produce maps to show their own journey to school, including any important features or landmarks.

We will be developing strategies with the children to help them resolve playground issues independently and confidently.

Finally, we will be exploring who I am and where I fit within the community.

In English we will be learning about:

- Letter writing

- Writing simple lists and instructions.

Mathematics

In Mathematics we will be learning about:

- Forming numbers
- Putting numbers in order
- I more and less than a given number
- Number bonds to 10 and 20
- Addition and subtraction problems
- Counting up to and back from 100
- Recognising shapes and colours

Seasonal Changes

We will be learning how to observe and describe the seasons and how day length varies.

Computing Introduction to Coding

We will use simple coding to direct and control Bee bots
